PROFICIENCY IN ENGLISH (for those whose first language is not English)

Candidates whose first language is not English, except for those who have resided in the United Kingdom or the Republic of Ireland for a period of three years or more preceding the commencement of their course, will normally be required to have passed, before admission, a test in English approved by the Senate. Candidates who have spent at least five months in the full-time study of English at a college in the United Kingdom and who, at interview, satisfy the Chairman of the School of Studies concerned as to their competence in English, shall be exempt from this requirement.

Qualifications acceptable for the purpose of satisfying the English language requirement

For any of the qualifications marked with *, a pass at the appropriate standard in either English Language or English Literature is acceptable provided the language of examination is English.

Qualifications other than those listed below offered by candidates as evidence of proficiency in English will be considered by the Senate on the recommendation of the Board of Studies concerned.
